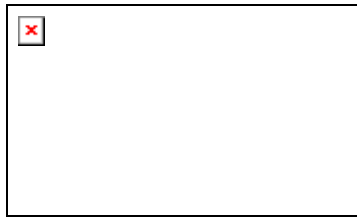

Catalyst Arts, the organisation that is seeking to encourage a renaissance in the creative arts from a biblical worldview, is hosting its first summer school this year in Eastbourne.

At the summer school you will find workshops suitable for people of all ages and backgrounds, from Baby Carousel for pre-walkers, up to various drawing, painting, writing, singing, music, drama, dance and craft workshops for young people and adults. The dates are **17-22 August 2009**, and workshops will take place at St Andrew's URC, Blackwater Road, Bonners Music Superstore and Eastbourne Prayer Centre, with other venues yet to be confirmed.

The summer school will finish with An Evening with Catalyst Arts hosted by Adrian and Bridget Plass at All Saints Church on 22nd August and will be featuring local artists.

Part of the vision of Catalyst Arts is to work collaboratively with other individuals, groups and organisations in Eastbourne, and it has encouraged others to become involved. If you'd like to get involved in this exciting new arts venture, here's how:

- **Publicity** – Help with distributing flyers and posters (some copies are enclosed).
- **Venues** – Help with hosting workshops in your church.
- **Tutors with teaching experience** - Help with running some workshops (such as music, crafts, etc.)

- **Materials** – Help with providing some materials such as stationery.
- **Fundraising** – Help with raising funds to get the summer school up and running.

Catalyst Arts aims to establish an environment in which creative expression and innovation can be explored by people of all ages, regardless of their culture and educational background. A developing vision is to make the arts accessible to the wider community, working with existing arts agencies. There will be a positive focus on encouraging and stimulating creativity with vocational and non-vocational objectives.
