Funding Secured for EU & EEA Coventry Residents

The Migration Team at Coventry City Council, in partnership with Coventry Law Centre, has secured funding to deliver the EU Settlement Scheme (EUSS) to support vulnerable EEA citizens to make an application for settled or pre-settled status. For those who *don't* make an application, new rules include a points-based immigration system or a possible No Recourse to Public Funds restriction.



There may be members of your congregation who have settled status and may appreciate some support from this scheme.

Barnardo's has launched a vital new support service to offer support to Black, Asian and minority ethnic children, young people and their families.

The new service is a free telephone helpline and web chat facility for children, young people and families from these communities who are experiencing the long-lasting and wide-ranging impact of Covid-19. It will provide on-going support on a complex range of issues including mental health, bereavement, family break-down, neglect, back to school, parenting advice, counselling, family stress, discrimination, barriers to services and more.

The police have launched a new safeguarding website www.actearly.uk aimed at family and friends to encourage them to share concerns that a friend or loved one might be vulnerable to radicalisation.

Research shows that Family and friends are best placed to spot the signs that someone might be vulnerable to radicalisation. We want them to ACT early so their vulnerable friend or loved one can get the support they need before the situation escalates into something more serious. This campaign is even more important than ever in the current pandemic climate where we have seen a decline in Prevent referrals during lockdown.
