About the Committee

The Parsonages & Glebe Committee is a subcommittee of the Finance, Resources & Risk Committee. It meets at least four times each year.

Key responsibilities:

- Monitor the state of repair of clergy housing, including inspection and survey reports.
- Approve leases, tenancies and rent reviews for glebe properties, as negotiated by the DBF's glebe agents.
- Advise and support in the delivery of the asset management and investment policies in relation to glebe land and properties.
- Oversee elements of the land disposal strategy, in line with the approved strategy, leading to recommendations to the DBF's trustees.

Committee Members

A range of skills, experience and knowledge is needed to enable the Committee to effectively fulfil their responsibilities.

We're looking for three to five lay members and one clergy member with skills and knowledge in one or more of the following areas:

- Property management
- Commercial property
- Quantity surveying
- Land management
- Sustainable management of land for biodiversity and climate

Individual members do not need to have experience across all of these areas.

Membership will run from July 2025 for a three-year term.
